

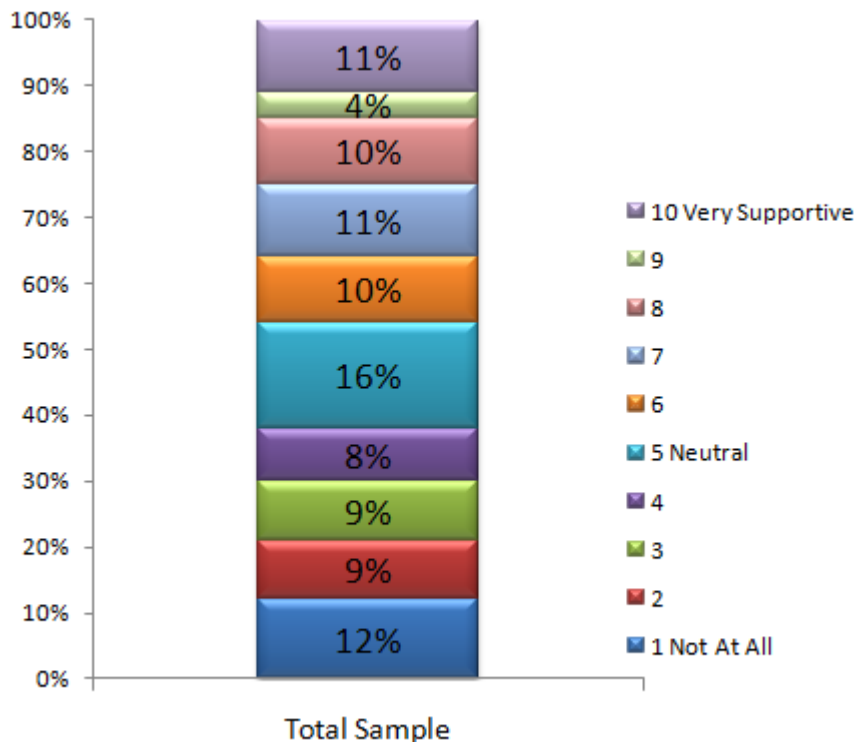


## 2010 U.S. Remote Working Research Summary National Survey Findings

- 62 percent of people surveyed believe they could fill their job duties at a remote location.
- More than half (59 percent) of those surveyed say their company does not have a formal policy allowing employees to work remotely.
- 63 percent of people surveyed do not take advantage of a remote working policy.
- 90 percent of those surveyed say privacy will not be compromised when working from home.
- 7.3 days: The average number of days people work from home.

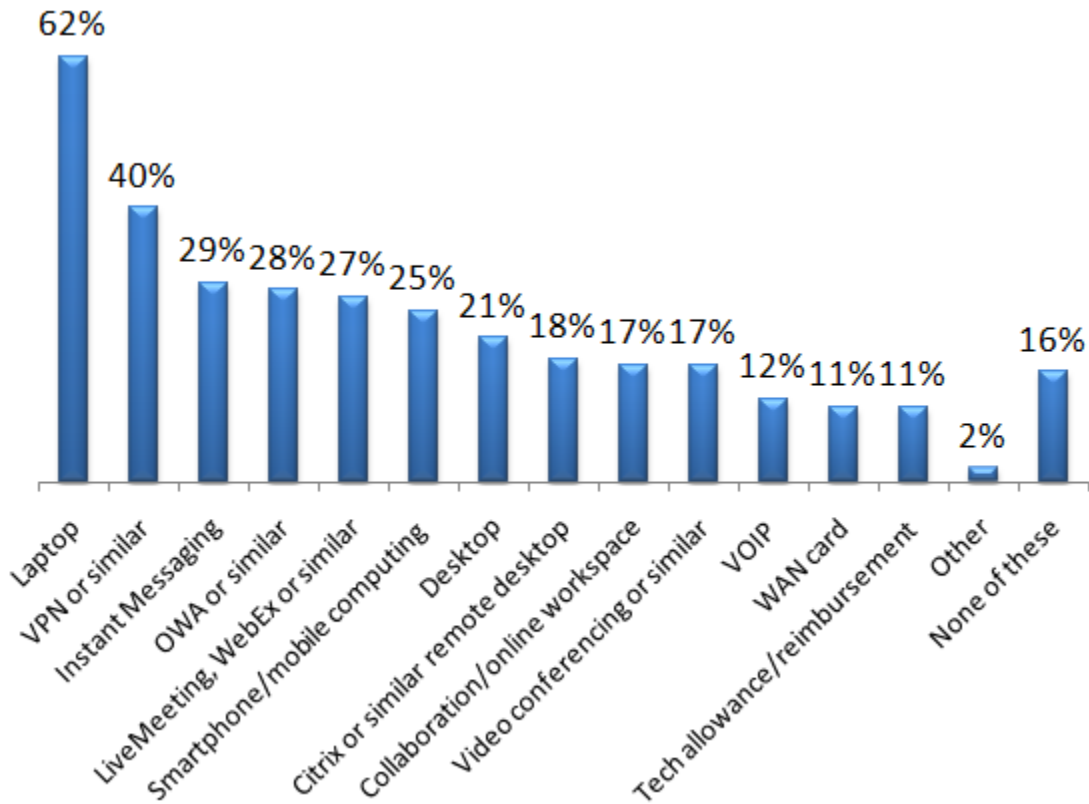
**According to employees, less than 50 percent of employers are supportive of remote working arrangements**

How supportive do you think your employer is of remote working arrangements?



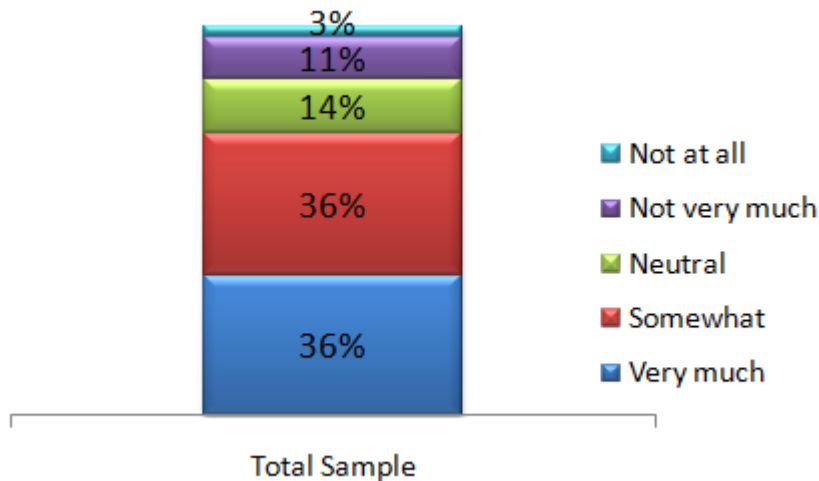
**While many companies offer technologies that enable remote working, most do not have a remote working policy**

Which of the following technologies does your company provide to support remote workers?



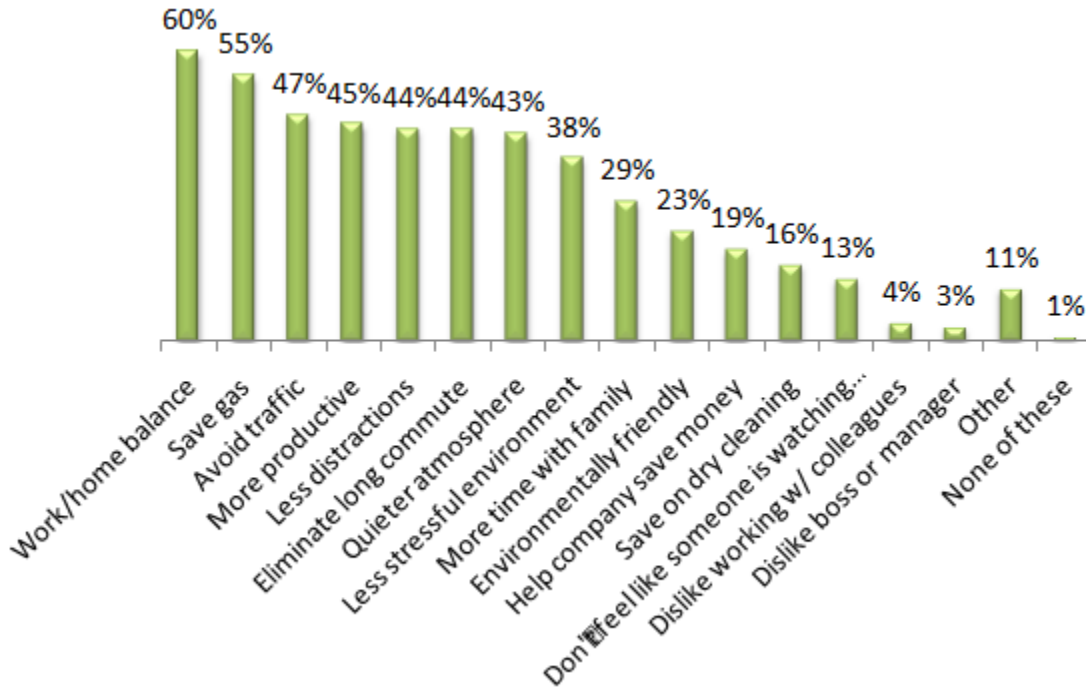
**Employees overwhelmingly prefer to work from home, away from the office environment**

Using the scale below, how strongly would you prefer to regularly work from home?



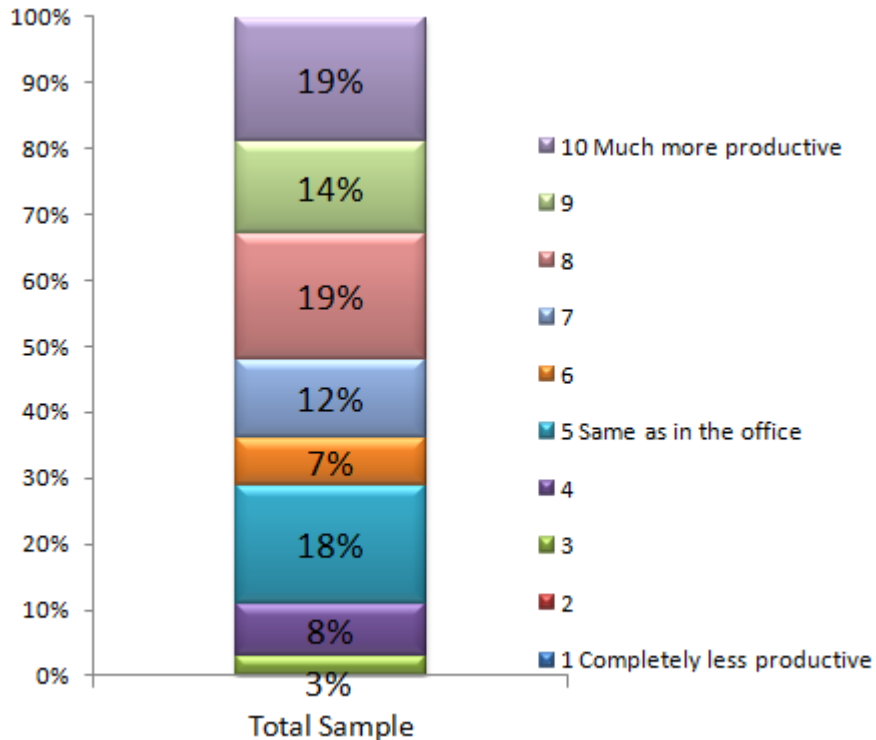
**Employees who take advantage of a remote working policy report many benefits including work/life balance, avoiding commutes and saving gas**

For which of the following reasons do you take advantage of your company's remote working policy?



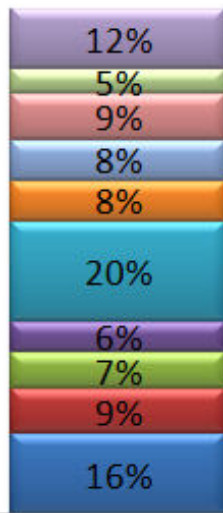
**Where are employees most productive? Survey says, not in the office**

How productive are you when you work remotely?



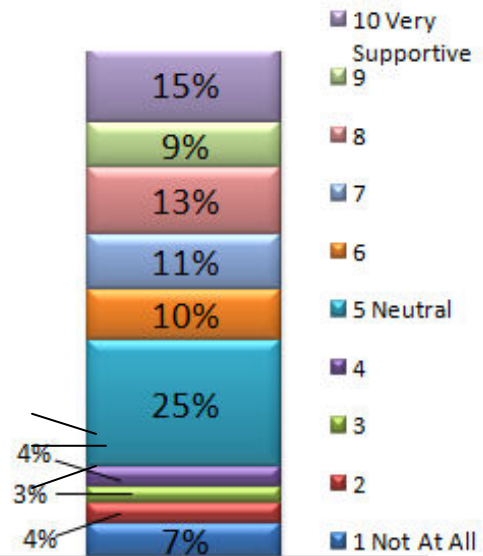
## Colleagues are more supportive of remote working than managers

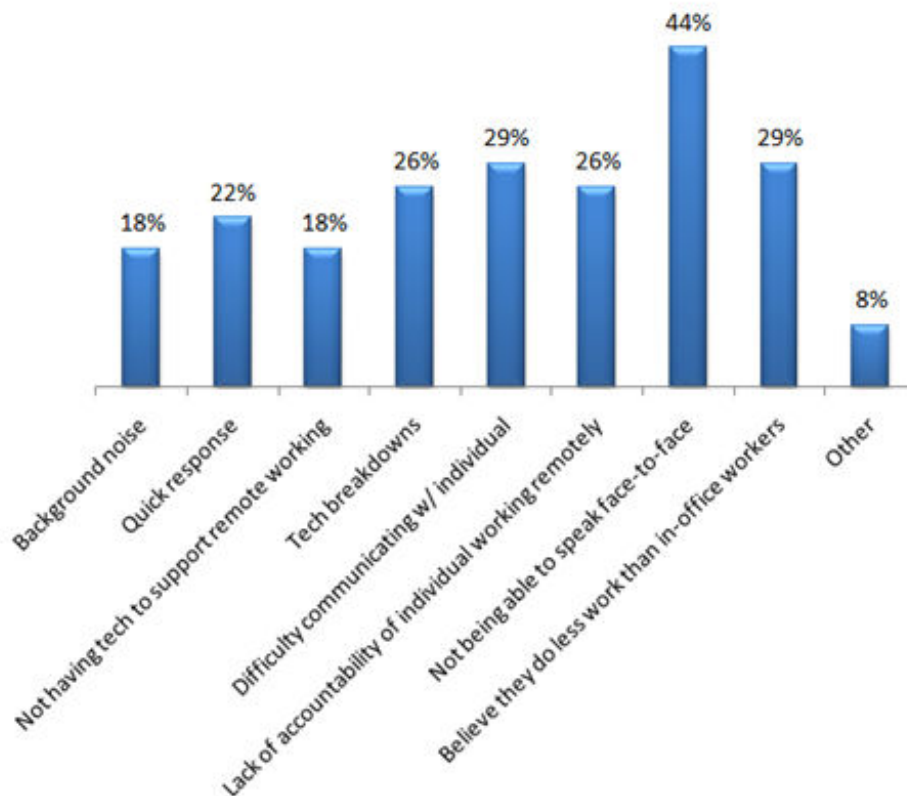
How supportive are your peers/colleagues of remote working arrangements?
