For a Windows-based PC:

- Windows Vista or Windows XP
- 100 MB of available hard disk space
- Available USB port on the PC
- Internet access for certain features

For Macintosh:

- Mac OS X v10.2x-10.5x
- 30 MB of available hard disk space
- Available USB port on the computer
- Internet access for certain features

Availability And Pricing:

The Wireless Mobile Mouse 3000 will be available later this month for an estimated retail price of \$29.95 (U.S.).³ The following special edition colors will be available only at Target stores: blue sapphire, red garnet, pink topaz and purple amethyst. All colors will be available later this year.

The Wireless Mobile Mouse 3000 in black and white is now available for special pre-sale on Amazon.com and will ship later this month when the product is widely released.
